Van Transportation

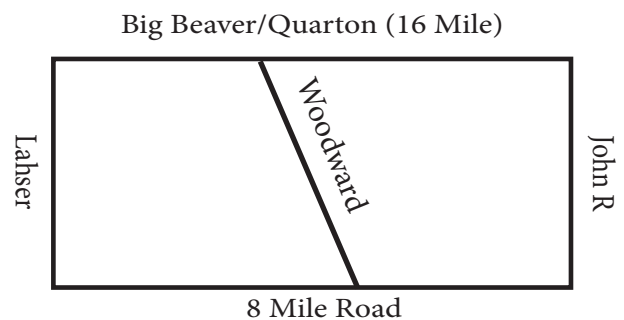
Senior Van Transportation is available for Berkley residents who are 50 or older, retired or semi-retired.

To make a van reservation:

- Reservations can be made Monday through Friday between the hours of 9:00 am and 11:00 am by calling 248.658.3470 and asking for transportation.
- Please be ready to provide your name, address and the address of where you will need to be dropped off.
- Please indicate if you will need special assistance including if you are using a walker or are in a wheelchair.
- Reservations need to be made at least two days in advance but can be made months in advance if you have all necessary information.

When scheduling rides, it is extremely important to have the address in which you need to be dropped off. Please make sure you have this information available when you call.

No changes, other than cancellations, will be made on the day of transportation. Additions will not be accepted. Please do not ask the driver to alter the schedule.
