We want to reach the community, not when things are bad, we want to do it all the time, so they know a bit about our background and that's why this is very helpful, so thank you.

You bring up the pandemic, I just want people to remember that these officers that are out on the street, they are the same ones that had the PPE on, coming to the homes and treating and transporting people that were COVID positive. I will tell you a little bit about my career. First of all, I'm very proud of what I do. I don't think there is a more honorable profession than being a Public Safety Officer or a Police Officer. With almost without exception in my career the men and women I've worked with are honorable people, there's a few exceptions but please those are exceptions, they are not the rule.
