

# Recycling



## Mandatory separation of waste and recyclables:

**PLASTICS:** Residents are now required to sort their plastics at the Transfer Station. Plastic's will be separated as follows. Look for the arrow triangle on the bottom of each bottle.

#1 Bottles only- These include all soda, juice, and water bottles. Please remove and discard all caps from plastics, they are not recyclable.

#2 Clear (natural) bottles and jugs only- These include all milk (not Hood's) and spring water bottles and jugs.

#2 Colored bottles and jugs only- These include laundry detergent, fabric softener, bleach, shampoo, juice bottles, etc.

*Note: All other plastics. #1 black platter plates or hardened black plastic, clear food trays (plastic egg cartons, vegetable, and fruit trays), #3, #5 & #7 plastic bowls, cups, and containers go in the "Mixed Plastics" container.*

## Just ask an attendant when in doubt.

**Plastics with any contamination (food and/or dirt) are not recyclable and must be placed in your blue bags as regular household trash.**

Aluminum beverage cans: Soda and beer only. No pet food cans or foil, this must be placed in "Tin Cans".

Antifreeze: Not mixed with oil. Place in the "Haz-Mat" area.

Ash: Wood and coal ash only. Place in ash bucket.

Asphalt Shingles: Shingles and tar paper are placed in the "Construction Bin".

Cardboard: Corrugated cardboard only- Glossy or Shiny is okay. Please flatten all boxes and place them on the table near the bailer area. Remove and discard all packing material in your blue PAYT bag.

Pizza boxes are okay as long as they are completely empty. No liners or pizza.

Non-corrugated paperboard goes in with "Mixed Paper".

Compost: Not accepted.

# Recycling

Computers/Electronics/Appliances (refrigerators, freezers, and dehumidifiers need to have DOORS REMOVED)/Bulky Items/Fluorescent lamps/Batteries/Propane tanks (No 100lb tanks):

Please see Fee Schedule.

Construction Bin: Pressure treated lumber, sheetrock, insulation, laminated wood, bulky household furniture. NO METAL. Please see the fee schedule.

Glass: Bottle glass and jars only. NO POCELINE, CHINA, POTTERY, MIRRORS, WINDOW GLASS, DRINKING GLASSES OR VASES. \*As of 2023 all glass can be thrown into the compactor as we do not have a glass recycling vendor available.\*

Inert Waste: Concrete, cured concrete, rock, brick, ceramic, porcelain, and china. Non-contaminated soil.

Leaf Pile: Leaves, grass, and plant clippings, organic materials, and sawdust. Please no plastic bags or trash.

Metal Bin: All metal. No trash, glass, or wood.

Mixed Paper Bin: Boxes that are NOT corrugated belong here along with brown paper bags, cereal boxes, all dry food boxes, detergent boxes, cracker boxes, gift boxes, office paper, junk mail, magazines, newspapers, paperback books, and hardcover books (covers removed).

Organic Matter:- Egg shells, coffee grounds, and vegetable scraps can be stored in paper bags only and dumped in the "Leaf Pile". Please do not leave plastic bags or containers in the pile.

Goodwill & Veteran's Boxes: Please place clothing, pillows, blankets, and other cloth items inside the boxes. **DO NOT leave items outside the boxes.** If the boxes are full, please bring your items back on your next visit.

Tin Cans: All metal and aluminum pet food cans, foil, and plates/pans. Please rinse out.

Tires: Fees apply. Please see the Fee Schedule.

Waste Oil: Place in the "Haz-Mat" area. No antifreeze, water mixed with oil, gasoline, or paint.

Yard Waste: Clean brush only, no grass or leaves.

**ITEMS NOT ACCEPTED: Animal or Agricultural waste, hazardous waste, automobile gas tanks, asbestos, septic tank residuals, junk vehicles or motorcycles, stumps, and logs over 4" in diameter.**
