AN ORDINANCE RESTRICTING THE THROWING OR BLOWING OF SNOW INTO STREETS AND ALLEYS IN THE CITY OF BEULAH, MERCER COUNTY, NORTH DAKOTA


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEULAH, MERCER COUNTY, NORTH DAKOTA, AS FOLLOWS:

1. No person or entity shall throw or blow in any manner snow or ice into any street or alley in the City of Beulah. The City Council of the City of Beulah has determined that the throwing or blowing of snow or ice into City streets and alleys constitutes a hazard to and impedes vehicular travel within the City of Beulah. Any person or entity violating the provisions of this Ordinance shall be guilty of an infraction.
2. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby rescinded and repealed.
3. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon final passage and publication of its title and penalty clause.
4. If any provision of this Ordinance or its application to any person or circumstances is held invalid, the remainder of the Ordinance or the application of the provision to other persons or circumstances is not affected.
