City of Big Rapids Waives Fees for 2024 Pool Season

The City of Big Rapids has announced that it will waive all fees at the Charles E. Fairman Community Pool for the 2024 season.

This decision, approved unanimously by the City Commission, aims to enhance community engagement and provide accessible recreational opportunities for all residents.

Josh Pyles, Community Pool Director, believes that eliminating fees will enable more children to learn to swim, aligning with one of the pool's main objectives.



"The Big Rapids Community is surrounded by different bodies of water, including the Muskegon River, several lakes, and a community pool," Pyles said. "It is of the utmost importance to teach our kids to learn how to swim at an early age."

The pool kicks off its 2024 season on June 10th; parents who want to register their kids for swim lessons can stop by the community pool from 1:00 pm to 7:45 pm. In addition, there will also be an evening open swim from 5 pm to 7:45 pm.

"Our police vehicles and officers are now equipped with Axon Fleet 3 in-car and Axon 4 body cameras, ensuring transparency accountability, and trust within our community."

Reminder: City enforces lawn/grass ordinance

Now that we're in June, it's a timely reminder for residents about the city's grass and lawn ordinance:

- The ordinance states that grass must not exceed six inches in height.
- Failure to comply will lead to a violation notice being issued.
- Repeat offenses by residents can result in the city taking action to have the grass cut which would result in the resident being billed for the work plus a 20% administrative fee
