# CITY OF BIG RAPIDS NEWSLETTER April. 2024 Edition



After extensive discussions by the Big Rapids Planning Commission and the City Commission earlier this year, the City of Big Rapids approved an ordinance last month for short-term rentals like (VRBO & Airbnb) with specific conditions in place to regulate them.



Short-term rentals will be permitted in certain areas as per the ordinance. These areas include R1 residential, RP residential professional, R2 mixed residential, R3 multi-family residential, RR restricted residential, and C2 commercial districts.

Occupancy in RR, R2, R3, and C2 districts is limited to two individuals per bedroom, with a maximum occupancy of 10 individuals per house.

Owner occupancy is required in R1 and RP districts and the maximum number of guests allowed is two.

"The Planning Commission and City Commission researched and came up with an ordinance that would open up some housing options to meet a niche market within the community while still protecting our residential neighborhoods," said Community Development Director Michelle Stenger.
