Big Rapids Dial-a-Ride now offers the 'Gold Pass' Program for Eligible Soniors and Active (Poticed Military Members

Seniors and Active/Retired Military Members

Big Rapids Dial-a-Ride is introducing the "Gold Pass" program, which offers discounted fares to eligible seniors aged 80 and older, as well as active and retired military members residing within the city limits.

According to City Manager Mark Gifford, the idea for a discounted program for individuals over 80 years old or active military/veterans was led by DART Supervisor Dawn Fuller. The Gold Pass program would allow them to use the DART system at a significantly reduced cost.



With the Gold Pass, eligible riders can pay a \$1 fee and ride DART free of charge for one year.

The current fare is \$2.50 per one-way ride for ages 17 through 59, and \$1.25 per one-way ride for children 4 to 16, disabled riders, and patrons 60 years old and older.
