VOTERS ARE NOW ABLE TO AUTOMATICALLY RECEIVE ABSENTEE BALLOTS FOR EVERY ELECTION

With the approval of Proposal 2, voters in Michigan can sign up for the permanent absentee ballot list.

On the Absent Voter Ballot Application, there is a section that reads "I want to vote absentee in all elections. Automatically send me an absent voter ballot for every election."

The May 2023 election was the first opportunity for voters to check this box, making the upcoming November election the first time those voters can skip the Absent Voter Application process and automatically receive a ballot.

If you wish to automatically receive a ballot for future elections, please check the box on the Absent Voter Ballot Application.

Hemlock Street to get repaved

The Public Works Department and its partner, Rieth-Riley Construction will be prepping and repaving Hemlock Street this month.

The project begins on Monday, October 9th with crews pulverizing and grading the road. Once completed, crews will put the asphalt leveling course on Friday, October 13th or earlier.

Officials say Hemlock Park will be open during that weekend.

Finally, hot mix asphalt will be applied during the week of October 16th, then opened up for the weekend again.

If you would like access to Hemlock Park during the week of construction, please park in the parking lot behind Big Rapids Middle School.
