

**BREITUNG TOWNSHIP BOARD  
REGULAR BOARD MEETING  
OCTOBER 10, 2022**

The meeting was called to order by Supervisor Olson at 6:00 p.m.

**Roll Call: Present:** Trustee Wales, Trustee Rochon, Supervisor Olson, Clerk Larson, Trustee Taff and Trustee Peterson. **Absent:** Treasurer Taylor excused.

Also Present: Superintendent Mulka.

Invocation given by: Supervisor Olson.

Pledge recited by all.

**Public Comment:** Start time: 6:03 p.m. End time: 6:07 p.m. Brian Julian of 720 East Breen Avenue expressed his concerns about the current truck route to the scrap yard in East Kingsford. There is a lot of damaging debris from the trucks left on the roads. He would like the Board to consider having the truck route changed. Supervisor Olson explained the Road Commission determines the truck routes. Supervisor Olson will talk to the Road Committee and the County Road Commission and will follow up with Mr. Julian.

**Engineering proposal for Tennis and Pickleball courts:** **Motion** by Trustee Taff, **second** by Trustee Peterson to approve Wickwire P.C.'s engineering proposal for the tennis, pickleball and basketball courts as presented. **Vote: Unanimous, motion carried.**

**Clerk's Financial Report:** **Motion** by Trustee Peterson, **second** by Trustee Rochon to approve Clerk Larson's Post Transaction Report from September 21, 2022 through October 6, 2022. **Vote: Unanimous, motion carried.**

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Fire Report - Highlights: Written report submitted by Fire Chief Rose. Supervisor Olson suggested a Thank You letter be sent to Town & Country Ford for the opportunity to provide training for our firefighters with the recent house burn on their property.

Superintendent Report - Highlights: Written report submitted by Township Superintendent Mulka. The Board requests that garage door remote controls be ordered to be kept in each of the fire trucks.

Code Enforcement Report: For the month of September 2022, the Breitung Township Officer handled the following: 8 accidents, 31 complaints, 1 code enforcement complaint and 3 arrests.

Supervisor Olson requested Rita provide Superintendent Mulka the information so the Board Members can review. The questions should be presented to the Central Landfill Committee, and these concerns brought to the Public Hearing.
