We did take delivery of our new (used) Rescue Truck. There is some additional work to be done on it locally and we will be planning on moving the equipment from R 300 to the new vehicle as soon as the work is completed.

The repair work in Engine 471 was completed. On 8/19 equipment was removed from Engine 481 and it was driven to Antigo and left to be serviced. Engine 471 was driven back to Station 2 and equipment from Engine 481 was loaded on it and placed in service at Station 2.

We are making plans to participate with IMFD on a Fire Safety Program being sponsored by the Dickinson County Library. The program will be Saturday October 9th from 10:00AM until noon. We will plan on sending Engine 481 and several FF's.

Other activity:

Work was completed on Engine 481 on 9/8/211. On 9/9/21 we picked it up and returned it to station. By the end of the day all engines were back in service at their normal stations.

All three stations completed their regular monthly Maintenance Meeting. I did stop at all three stations and spoke with the individuals there.

On Saturday September we had 8 FF's, representing all three stations, completed Stair climbs in remembrance of the lives lost on September 11,2001. Stair climbs were held at Pine Mountain and Lambeau Field.
