July 9, 2021

- Meetings that I have attended or will be attending:
 - June 3rd Water and Sewer Board Meeting (no quorum, held committee update)
 - July 8th Planning Commission
 - July 12th Meeting with County Controller
 - July 13th 6:00pm Special Meeting on Industrial Park
- Zoning / Permits
 - Broadband Fiber line build starting the week of July 12th near Escanaba. Their current website is at: https://link.edgepilot.com/s/567cfc25/-eW8MO1_O0GY1zeV5NqNKA?u=http://www.highlinefast.com/
 - Process requests and furnish information on land use, Environmental history and zoning regulations of parcels for possible future development.
 - Process applications for: zoning permits, conditional use permits and variances.
 - We are getting applications for new home construction, though some may be delayed or downsized due to contractor availability and increased prices for lumber.
- Personnel:
 - The Personnel committee is scheduling a meeting with the Assessor for the week of July 12th.
- Infrastructure
 - Working with the DPW Superintendent to compile past and current engineering studies to evaluate options for the Board to consider for direction to apply for funding for improvements.
 - Initial examples of costs for security cameras and electronic door locks were in your June 14th Board packet FYI's. I would like further direction from the Board as the costs are significant, and those items / upgrades would require a budget amendment if done in this fiscal year. The Initial estimate for electronic locks on our facilities would be about \$40,000; their company representative will be stopping in next week to review our facilities and verify internet connections of each building. There would also be software installation and maintenance costs.
 - I would like to meet with the infrastructure committee on what we could focus on to contain costs and provide improvements in security at our facilities, and service to our residents.
