July 23, 2021

- Zoning / Permits

 - Process requests and furnish information on land use, Environmental history and zoning regulations of parcels for possible future development.
 - Process applications for: zoning permits, conditional use permits and variances.
 - We are getting applications for new home construction, though some may be delayed or downsized due to contractor availability and increased prices for lumber.
- Personnel
 - The Personnel committee has been meeting with fire department personnel and Assessing.
- Infrastructure
 - I would like to meet with the infrastructure committee on what we could focus on to contain costs and provide improvements in security at our facilities, and service to our residents. Part of the recovery funds are supposed to be used to allow us to continue services during future possible events, while protecting our employees and the public.
- Fire Department
 - Working with the Fire Department on equipment, maintenance, and training needs.
 - Notification of any Grant award for the SCBAs is still delayed.
 - The rescue truck is ready for pickup in Illinois and we are awaiting delivery to a vendor in Green Bay for minor body repair and lettering.
- GRANTS
 - Recovery fund application submitted July 21st
 - Scrap Tire Cleanup Grant. Awarded May 19th.
 - FEMA Grant for SCBAs (awaiting award notification).
 - DNR Volunteer Fire Assistance Grant Program; pending.
- ORDINANCES

The proposed Ordinance amendments / additions have been submitted to the Township Attorney for review. He has been invited to the meeting (remote attendance) to review and offer other options.
