## December 27<sup>th</sup>, 2022 Board Meeting Report

December 15, 2022

- Infrastructure

- The Board had approved the LED upgrade to the DPW building, with the direction to change the outside lights to fixtures that we could change the color for events, if the pricing seemed reasonable. The pricing for exterior color change lights would increase the cost by over \$5,000. MJ electric will proceed with the original project scheduled for February. They will research installing two exterior lights with basic color change capabilities with better unit pricing and will have the option for review before the February installation.
- Met with vendor representatives \on the Refuse bid packet. Also meeting with the Road Commission to explore methods for reducing the damage and wear of the Garbage trucks on secondary seasonal roads and methods for less interruptions in service due to winter road conditions
- We have been receiving complaints of discontinued garbage pickup on some roads due to either winter road conditions and/or using larger 4 axle trucks. Residents had not been contacted about any changes. I have requested that GFL identify the roads affected, and to contact the customers for arrangements to get their garbage picked up along with notifying the utility Clerk.

- Zoning / Permits

- Process requests and furnish information on land use, environmental history, and zoning regulations of parcels for possible future development.
- Process applications for: zoning permits, conditional use permits, and variances.

- Additional:
  - The Tire Grant concluded on December 1<sup>st</sup>, and I am in the process of submitting for reimbursement of expenses. I have submitted a request to process a site-specific cleanup on Superior Ave near Alter Metal where there is a garage full and a pile 65' x 30' x 5'. Estimating 750 tires, the recycle contractor will be charging over \$4,000 to pick up and dispose of them. If the resident had brought them in before Dec 1<sup>st</sup>, the Township was covering the cost of what the grant did not cover or about \$1,800. I would like to request that the Board extend the gap cost coverage to this resident. I have also submitted a request to EGLE for Grant funding of a site specific cleanup. She did not expect the tires to stay, and her grandson has left town. She most likely would not be able to cover the 4k. With the TWP gap coverage I am hoping to put her on a payment schedule for the balance.
