- **Building addition:** a request for proposals has been distributed, and advertising scheduled.

- ADDITIONAL:

- The Township Scrap Tire Grant application has been approved by EGLE for \$9,000. With the way winter has been, I would like to set the program date to start April 1st. We will have some procedures to work out with GFL now that EGLE is requiring direct vendor payments to Liberty Tire. This reduces a lot of paperwork but may create a need to develop our own drop-off site at the DPW.
- The February 7th meeting with Highline and AEG at the Road Commission was in preparation for the installation of Fiber Optic cable installation in the Township under the FCC Grant to provide underserved areas access to high-speed internet. There will be timelines and more information coming to post on our website that will show which areas will have fiber optic available (1 gigabyte upload and download speeds). The hookup fee will be \$200 and provides up to 2,000 feet of underground installation from the Road Right-of-Way to the residence.
