- Infrastructure

- **Building addition:** a request for proposals has been distributed with a number of inquiries for information. The deadline is March 11<sup>th</sup>.
- **DPW Storage Building:** discussion has been ongoing about salvaging the building and holding off until a comprehensive evaluation of additional capital improvements which may change needs and types of use.
- **Park Project/s:** the P&R committee met on the 6<sup>th</sup>, and will be meeting before the regular meeting of the 12<sup>th</sup>. Initial recommendations are for improvements in parking areas, ice rink surface, and up to two miles of paved path, walkway that will connect with DCRC 2023's sidewalk installation along Lincoln.

- Zoning / Permits

- Process requests and furnish information on land use, environmental history, and zoning regulations of parcels for possible future development.
- Process applications for: zoning permits, conditional use permits, and variances.



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- MASTER PLAN:
  - Our Master Plan is still in the review period with the Public Hearing scheduled for March 14<sup>th</sup> at the Planning Commission meeting.
  - FYI, the County has announced they are updating their Master Plan. There is a survey available to participate in.
  
- ADDITIONAL:
  - Aspire Networks dba Highline Metro permit has been reviewed and issued for working in the right-of-way to install fiber optic cable in the Township.
