### February 28<sup>th</sup>, 2022 Board Meeting Report

February 25, 2022

- Meetings:
  - February 18<sup>th</sup>, DCRC meeting with Townships on 2022 projects
  - February 24<sup>th</sup>, DCRC meeting with Townships on 2022 projects
  - February 24<sup>th</sup>, Economic Development Alliance Meeting
  - March 8<sup>th</sup>, Economic Development Alliance Meeting
  - March 10<sup>th</sup>, Planning Commission Meeting (two public hearings)
- Zoning / Permits
  - Process requests and furnish information on land use, Environmental history, and zoning regulations of parcels for possible future development.
  - Process applications for: zoning permits, conditional use permits, and variances.
- Personnel
  - Hope to have a recommendation for Utility Clerk / Administrative Assistant at the meeting
- Infrastructure
  - Gathering information on a water system improvement for East Kingsford to allow fire suppression systems to be available to industrial properties and increase fire flow capacity to the neighborhood, as well as a possible main extension to provide a loop to a dead-end water main. The lead-copper service line replacement plan will resume this summer.
  - DCRC Bids will be let for the 2022 Road construction schedule in March and will be submitted to the Board for review when received.
- Grants
  - With ARPA funds available for infrastructure, it is a great opportunity for water system improvements. There was prior discussion of allocating seventy thousand for the lead copper line replacement. Without the ARPA funds, the Water funds would have to borrow to replace service lines.
- Additional
  - Surplus DNR Property has been listed for public auction for 2022. The Township has the option to acquire before any public auction. There is a parcel on Old Carney Lake Road that the Township may consider acquiring for Public Use. The application was submitted by the deadline which was February 14<sup>th</sup>. They waived the requirement of the \$300 filing fee by the deadline allowing us to send it in this month. There was less than two weeks' notice, and this keeps the option of first right of refusal for the Township allowing time to evaluate the property this spring when the snow melts.
