Social Distancing

Please continue to practice social distancing, including on the playgrounds. Social distancing, also called "physical distancing," means keeping space between yourself and other people outside of your home. To practice social or physical distancing:

- **You must wear a mask when in any common areas, including hallways and laundry rooms.**
- Stay at least 6 feet (about 2 arms' length) from other people
- Do not gather in groups
- Stay out of crowded places and avoid mass gatherings
