Office Closed

Social Distancing

Please continue to practice social distancing, including on the playgrounds. The CDC guidelines for social distancing are as follows:

Social distancing, also called “physical distancing,” means keeping space between yourself and other people outside of your home. To practice social or physical distancing:

- Stay at least 6 feet (about 2 arms’ length) from other people
- Do not gather in groups
- Stay out of crowded places and avoid mass gatherings

Rescheduled Clean Up Day

On Tuesday, June 23, 2020 we will be having Clean-Up day. On this day only you may place any large items out for pick up & we will pick them up free of charge. It is your responsibility to transport items to the curb by noon.

Extermination Notice – Ants, spiders, etc. – June 19, 2020

On Friday, June 19, 2020, Rose Pest Solutions will be spraying around the perimeter of EVERY building. In case of rain Friday, June 26, 2020 will be the make-up date. Please clean up the area around your unit and remove all lawn furniture, toys, plants, lawn ornaments, etc. from the outside perimeter of your apartment, (about 3ft. from the building). Toys and other items should be placed in the sheds. On Thursday, June 18, 2020 we will be checking to make sure the areas around your apartment are clear and anyone in non-compliance will receive a notice. Pets should not be outside during the application. The exterminator recommends having all windows shut during the application.

Income

"I agree I must immediately notify the Landlord or cooperative when there is a change in my gross income or adjustment to income of \$100 per month or when there is a change in the number of persons living in the household. I also understand that failure to report such changes may result in my losing benefits to which I may be entitled or may result in the Landlord/Cooperative or Agency taking corrective action if benefits were mistakenly received."

If your income changes more than \$100 per month you must contact the office as soon as possible.
