COVID-19 Operations Update

Due to the recent increase in COVID-19 cases, the Big Rapids Housing Commission is taking extra precautions. Community rooms will remain closed for the safety of all residents. Please make sure you continue to call in all repairs (work orders), however, work orders will be completed as necessary only.

Social Distancing/COVID-19 Reminders

There is currently no vaccine to prevent COVID-19. The best way to prevent illness is to avoid being exposed to this virus. We want to remind all residents to social distance in ALL common areas (hallways, playgrounds, laundry rooms) and to WEAR MASKS.

- Stay at least 6 feet (about 2 arms' length) from other people.
- Do not gather in groups.
- Stay out of crowded places & avoid gatherings, especially if you are sick or have COVID symptoms

Illegal Drug Use

Please be advised that Meadow Park Apartments prohibits the use of all illegal drugs, including marijuana, regardless if you have a medical marijuana card. If you believe illegal drug activity is occurring, please call Central Dispatch at 231-796-4811 or 9-1-1.

Parking on City Streets

Beginning November 15, 2020 parking is not allowed on city streets from 2:00 a.m. – 6:00 a.m. until March 15, 2021. This is to allow for snow removal. You will be ticketed and/or towed if you park on the streets during this time.

Snow Removal Reminders

Please DO NOT pull your car over the curb. This blocks the sidewalks and makes snow removal difficult.

Maintenance Reminders to All Residents

If you are aware of an emergency work order, such as having no heat, or toilet not flushing – call during hours of operation, if possible! Please do NOT wait until the end of the day to report an issue you were aware of earlier in the day! Also, do not dump grease down your sinks. Pour hot grease in a tin container, and when it has cooled then throw it away in the trash. Grease will clog the lines and a charge will apply if grease is found to be the cause of your clogged sink.
