Burlingame Avenue Parking In Lieu Fees are applicable only to commercial properties within Downtown Burlingame and are collected in those instances where a land-use requires additional parking, but the site cannot physically accommodate additional spaces. The fee is based upon a per-space, or portion thereof that is not being provided on the property. The funds are to remain in the City's Parking fund to help defray the cost of building a City-owned and operated parking structure. The fees are updated annually based on the February Consumer Price Index – Urban Wage Earners and Clerical Workers (CPI-W) for the San Francisco Area.

AFFORDABLE HOUSING IMPACT FEES (PLANNING)

Commercial Affordable Housing Linkage Fees were adopted by the City Council in 2017 to provide a dedicated source of funding for programs supporting workforce housing in Burlingame.

- Retail - \$7.00 per square foot (\$5.00 w/ prevailing wages)
- Hotel - \$12.00 per square foot (\$10.00 w/ prevailing wages)
- Office projects of 50,000 square feet or less - \$18.00 per square foot (\$15.00 w/ prevailing wages)

Residential Impact Fees were adopted by the City Council in 2019.
