

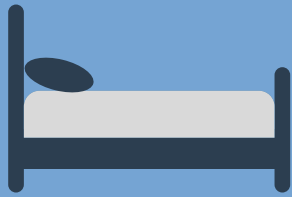
QUICK GUIDE TO

PROPER BULKY ITEM & HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE DISPOSAL

BURLINGAME MUNICIPAL CODE 8.6.020 PROHIBITS THE DUMPING OF DEBRIS, BULKY ITEMS, AND HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE ON PRIVATE AND PUBLIC PROPERTY. YOU MAY BE FINED UP TO \$500 PER DAY FOR ILLEGAL DUMPING.

PLACING AN ITEM BY THE CURB WITH A SIGN LABELED "FREE" IS STILL ILLEGAL DUMPING.

GOT BULKY ITEMS?

Sell them on Craigslist, Facebook Marketplace, or NextDoor.

Donate them to a local thrift store, (e.g., Goodwill, Pick of the Litter). Call the store ahead of time to confirm they will accept the item(s).

GOT HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE (HHW)?

HHW is waste from your home, that is toxic, corrosive, flammable or reactive, based on its chemical properties. Examples include paint thinner, toilet bowl cleaner, batteries, and rat bait.

It is illegal and unsafe to dump this waste in the trash or down the drain.
