## Short-Term Rentals in Burlingame

The City of Burlingame has created a program for short-term rentals that balances allowing residents to host guests in their homes for short-term stays, with the desire to preserve the residential character of the city's neighborhoods.

The term "short term rentals" (STRs) refers to the rental of existing residential units to occupants on a short-term basis, generally less than 30 days. Common examples include renting a room, house, or an apartment for a week or weekend for a short stay, or for several weeks. Short-term rentals are most commonly offered and rented through

online hosting platforms such as Airbnb, Vrbo, Hostmaker, Sonder, Vacasa, and HomeAway, though they can also be offered offline.

The City's short-term rental program allows residents to rent out their entire home or apartment "unhosted" (without the host present) for up to 120 days per year. There is no limit on "hosted" rentals where the host is onsite.

The City is putting together an online registration platform that will make it easy for hosts to register their short-term rentals. Starting later this month, short-term rental operators will be contacted and provided with instructions on how to register. ## Commission Application Deadlines Extended for Beautification Commission and Parks & Recreation Commission

## New Water Waste Restrictions

The City has a new Wasteful Water Use Restrictions ordinance that targets and prohibits wasteful water use actions.

The following uses of potable water are prohibited at all times:

- Use of a hose without a positive shut-off nozzle.
- Use of water for cleaning, filling, or operating non-recirculating, decorative water fountains.
- Use of water to irrigate outdoor plants, grass, or landscaping during and within 24 hours of rainfall.
- Use of broken or defective plumbing, sprinkler, watering, or irrigation systems.

In addition, hotels and motels must provide guests with the option of choosing not to have towels and linens laundered daily.

## PARKING LOT E CLOSURE NOTIFICATION



**Parking Lot E will be closed to make way for the new Town Square & Mixed Use Development at the former Post Office.**

### POST OFFICE PROJECT – 220 PARK ROAD

- Redevelopment & restoration of portions of former Post Office
- New office development with ground floor retail
- 280 below-grade parking spaces (public use evenings & weekends)
- Includes removal of magnolia street trees along Lorton Avenue and Primrose Road

### Town Square Project – Parking Lot E

- The City of Burlingame will be developing a town square/community open space on Lot E, envisioned to be the heart of Downtown

**Construction Expected to Start Mid-August /Early September 2021**

**Make Your Dog Proud!**

As a friendly reminder, the City of Burlingame would like to remind all dog owners to pick up after your dogs. It's the responsible, respectful, and sanitary thing to do!

Here is the full text of **Burlingame Municipal Code 9.04.080** regarding the removal of canine excrement: "No person owning or having custody or control of any dog shall knowingly or through failure to exercise due care or control, permit such dog to defecate and allow such excrement to thereafter remain on any public property, including parks, parking lots, sidewalks, planting strips and parkways, or upon any private property without the consent of the owner or occupant thereof." (Ord. 1106 § 1, (1977); Ord. 1137 § 1, (1978)).
