Free Parking at 161 Highland Parking Garage Through September 21

Good news Burlingame! 64 parking spaces are now available for public use at the new City parking structure currently under construction at 161 Highland Avenue. Because this is a "soft opening" of the 368-space garage, which will fully open on September 22, please note:

- The Highland Avenue vehicle and pedestrian entrances are open.
- **The Lorton Avenue vehicle entrance is closed.**
- There is a 10-hour parking limit (signs will be posted), and the Police Department will enforce this requirement.
- Parking is not permitted between the hours of 12:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m. (signs will be posted).
- The electric vehicle charging stalls are available; payment can be made via the downloadable Powerflex app.
- Parking fees are being waived through September 21.

You also will provide the Burlingame City Council with regular program information in regard to your position on the Board.

WHAT ARE THE REQUIREMENTS: You must be a Burlingame resident. You must be at least 21 years old. You do not need any experience in biology or any other health-related sciences to be a valuable member.

HOW OFTEN DO YOU SERVE: The City council can appoint you to either a two-year or four-year term. The regular Board meetings are held on the second Wednesday of each month, beginning at 6:00 p.m. The next Board meeting will be held on October 13, 2021.
