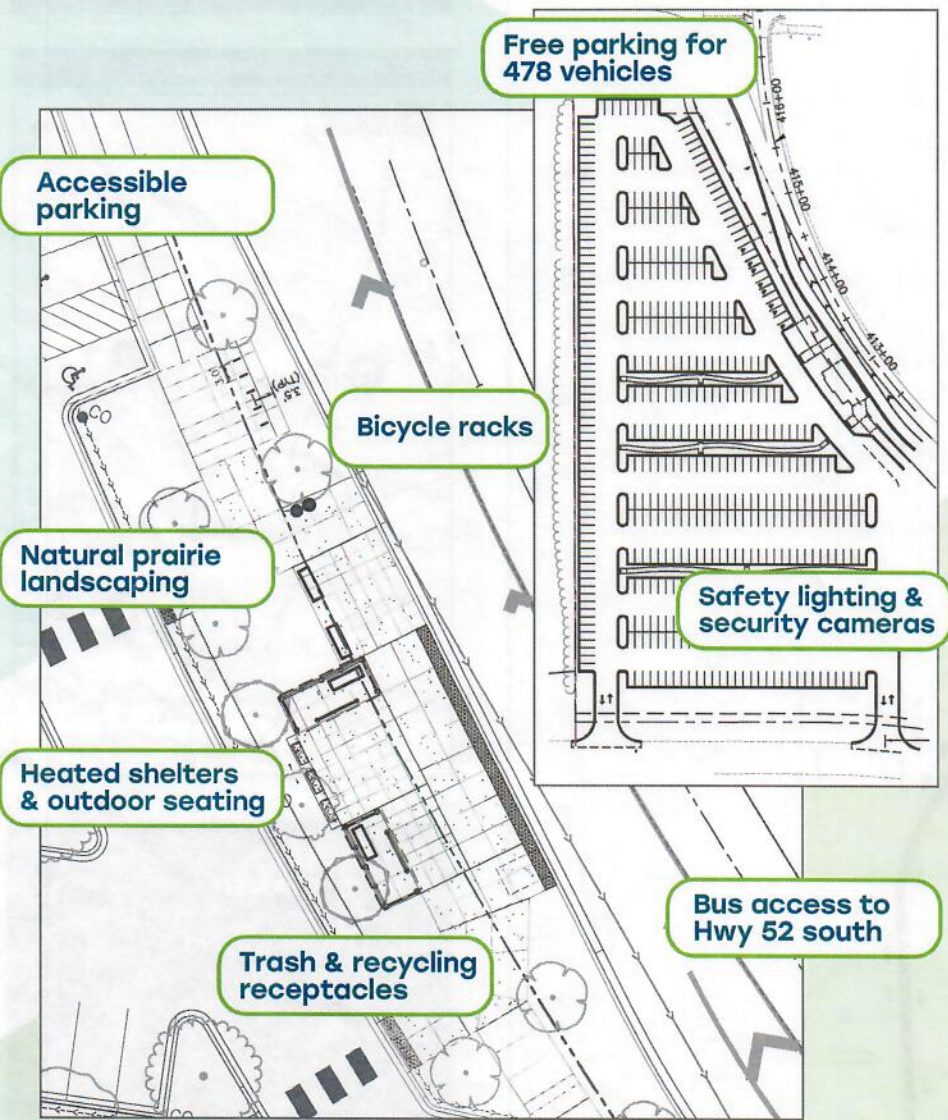




# Rochester Public Transit 75th Street Park & Ride

Ribbon cutting: May 29, 2024  
First day of service: June 3, 2024



The 75th Street Park & Ride was designed for a single purpose: to provide commuters with a safe, convenient, and sustainable way to travel to Downtown Rochester.

It is the first park-and-ride owned by the City of Rochester. The Transit & Parking department operates four other leased facilities.

The location, at the intersection of 75th Street NW and Hwy 52, was identified in the ROCOG Long-range Transportation Plan as a key to alleviating downtown congestion. The facility was also anticipated in Rochester Public Transit's latest five-year transit plan.

With frequent direct service during peak times, this strategically located facility is poised to play an important role in meeting the mobility needs of the future.
