BOARD MINUTES**

March 3, 2008

Members present were: Chairman Lenny Laures, Supervisors Arlen Heathman, Harold Atkinson and Clerk\Treasurer Joe Vroman.

Call to order at 6:00 pm at The Calvary Evangelical Free Church Meeting Room. All in attendance recited the Pledge Of Allegiance.

Sheriff Deputy's Report:

At 6:45pm, Deputy Val Coe reported nothing special had happened for the past month.

Township Board Old Business

- The minutes from the February meeting were read by Vroman and were approved on a motion by Atkinson, seconded by Heathman, all voted in favor.
- Supervisor Atkinson made a motion to pay the February Joint Powers bill of \$18,175.88, seconded by Heathman, all voted in favor.
- A motion to pay the remaining bills was made by Atkinson, seconded by Heathman, all voted in favor to pay the total bills of \$21,127.49.
- Treasurer Vroman gave the financial report at the meeting. Beginning balance was \$267,052.56, which included the February checking interest of \$504.77, and income deposited in February from gas tax of \$19,874.04 for a total February deposit of \$20,378.81. Checks written totaled \$21,127.49, for an ending checking balance of \$245,925.07. Motion to approve the treasurers report was made by Atkinson, seconded by Heathman, all voted in favor.

Township Board New Business

- At 7:00pm, Joe Kocer of 65th Street NW came before the board to discuss a previous metes and bounds issue of 20 years ago. After much discussion on the subject, Mr. Kocer will again contact the County Assessors Office and his attorney for answers.
- In addressing the e-mail request from Diana Chute for the prior 2 years of minutes and agendas, she stated to the board that she was looking for the snow plowing policy for the township. After some discussion on this subject, the board answered her questions about the snow plowing and she stated that she did not need the past 2 years of minutes and agendas.
