OLMSTED COUNTY – MINNESOTA BOARD MINUTES

AUGUST 6, 2012

Call to order at 6:00 pm at the new Cascade Town Hall Meeting Room. All in attendance recited the Pledge of Allegiance.

Members present were: Chairman Lenny Laures, Supervisor Arlen Heathman, Supervisor Harold Atkinson, and Clerk\Treasurer Joe Vroman.

Attendees present: Deputy Clerk Mike Brown, John Archbold, Deputy Val Coe.

Township Board Continuing Business.

- A motion by Supervisor Heathman to approve the minutes from the July 9th meeting as presented, seconded by Atkinson, motion approved.
- A motion by Heathman to pay the July Joint Powers bill of \$15,717.94, seconded by Atkinson, motion approved.
- A motion by Laures to pay the remaining Cascade bills, seconded by Atkinson, all voted in favor to pay the total bills of \$68,143.81, motion approved.

Treasurer Vroman gave the financial report at the meeting:

Vroman corrected the ending balance as of the close of the June 4th meeting
To read \$160,196.13 missed the PERA & Federal tax pmt's.

The checkbook balance at the end of the July 9th, 2012 meeting was \$401,320.59

Motion to approve the treasurer's report was made by Heathman, seconded by Atkinson, motion approved.

Sheriff Deputy's Report:

Deputy Val Coe updated the Board on her patrol activities. There were 30 calls for service since last Township meeting.

Township Board New Business

At 7:00PM, Chairman Laures requested that a letter from Cascade Township to Sheriff Mueller asking to have Sheriff Deputy Val Coe continue her duties as neighborhood community policing person for Cascade Township. Motion approved.

Discussion

The road near Veit Disposal that runs east from 60th Avenue NW should possibly be overlaid this year if possible. Laures, Heathman and Atkinson will meet Wednesday August 8 at 10:00 AM to review the road condition.

Supervisor Heathman made a motion to approve the agreement for the environmental corridor in River Highlands subdivision and allow the clerk and chairman to sign the agreement when completed. This was seconded by Atkinson, motion approved.

The meeting date for September was approved to be Tuesday, September 4th following Labor Day.

Clerk Vroman is to write a thank you letter to Joe Kocer thanking him for his service on the Planning Commission.

Chairman Laures reminded everybody about the picnic on Wednesday August 22nd at the town hall.
