ROAD INSPECTION MINUTES

JUNE 14, 2013

Call to order at 2:30 pm at the Cascade Town Hall Meeting Room.

Members present were: Chairman Lenny Laures, Supervisor Arlen Heathman, Supervisor Harold Atkinson, and Clerk/Treasurer Michael Brown

The township was notified by the road contractor of an imminent start to township road work. Road maintenance supervisor Laures reviewed the pricing for the roads identified for restoration in 2013. The four roads are Cameron Drive, Coventry Lane, Carlisle Lane, and Trapper Lane.


The board reviewed the cost against the 2013 budget. The recommendation from Supervisor Laures was to complete all four roads with only the 2 inch base layer with the 1.5 inch wear layer to be completed next year. Each layer would incorporate the polymer upgrade. This option consumes the entire 2013 road budget including the amount allocated to shouldering. Additional discussion ensued regarding the budget and the merits of the polymer upgrade mix.

- A motion by Supervisor Heathman to adopt the recommendation to complete all four roads with only the 2 inch base layer to be followed in 2014 with the wear layer. Second by Atkinson.
