Amendment to Cascade Township Parking Ordinance 2008-1

WHEREAS, Cascade Township has reviewed its Parking Ordinance and found that adding additional language would be beneficial for enforcement of its parking regulations, and

WHEREAS, the Cascade Township Board of Supervisors has reviewed the current Parking Ordinance, and

WHEREAS, a public hearing was duly noticed and held on February 12th 2024, at the Cascade Town Hall by the Cascade Township Board of Supervisors. The Board took public input on the proposed changes in the Cascade Township Parking Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, having heard the public and duly studied the proposed changes as listed below,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT AND IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED that Cascade Township Parking Ordinance 2008-1, is amended as follows:


(Pursuant to Minn. Stat. 169.04 and 365.10 subd.17)

Subd. 1. Parking Restrictions: No vehicle, trailer, dumpster, construction equipment, construction or other material shall be parked upon any township roadway or right-of-way overnight or continuously for a 24 hour period. The parking of any portion of the vehicle, trailer, dumpster, construction equipment, construction or other material such that only a portion of the vehicle is upon the roadway of any Town roadway or right-of-way shall be considered the same as if the entire vehicle, trailer, dumpster, or construction equipment were so parked.

Subd. 2. Seasonal Parking Restrictions: No person shall park a vehicle, trailer, dumpster, construction equipment, construction or other material upon any Town roadway or right-of-way any time when there are two (2) or more inches of unplowed snow and/or ice on any Town roadway.

Subd. 3. Vehicles May Be Ticketed and Towed: Any vehicle, trailer, dumpster, or construction equipment found to be in violation of the above, or which obstructs traffic and/or presents a public safety issue may be tagged by a law enforcement officer-and the owner of the vehicle, trailer, dumpster, or construction equipment shall be charged by citation, and if the vehicle, trailer, dumpster, or construction equipment constitutes a public safety hazard, it may be towed to a place of storage at the owner's expense, and not released to the owner until all expenses have been paid. Construction or other material found to be in violation of the above, or which obstructs traffic and/or presents a public safety issue may be removed from the roadway or right of way at the owner's expense, and not released to the owner until all expenses have been paid.

Subd. 4. No unlicensed/unregistered vehicle shall be parked anywhere in the township where it is visible from public or neighboring properties.

Subd. 5. Criminal Penalties: Every person who violates any provision of this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and shall, upon conviction, be subject to a fine or imprisonment or both, not to exceed the maximum penalty authorized by State law for a misdemeanor, plus, in either case, the costs of prosecution. Each act of violation and each day a violation occurs or continues shall constitute a separate offense.

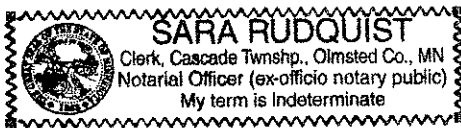
Subd. 6. Definitions:


1. **Vehicle:** "Vehicle" means any device for carrying one or more passengers, goods, or equipment, whether self-propelled or not.
2. **Roadway:** "Roadway" means that portion of a public street, or alley improved, designed, or ordinarily used for vehicular travel, exclusive of the sidewalk or shoulder. In the event a roadway includes two or more separate roadways, the term "roadway" as used herein shall refer to any such roadway separately but not all such roadways collectively.
3. **Town:** "Town" means Cascade Township, Olmsted County, Minnesota.

Subd. 7. Effective Date: This Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon its passage.

A motion was made by Gary Sieck and was seconded by Brad Brech to adopt. The motion carried with 5 yes votes, 0 no votes and 0 abstentions.

Passed and adopted by the Cascade Town Board this 12th day of February 2024.

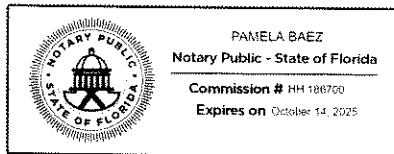
