

ANNUAL CEMETERY CLEAN-UP February – March

Around the middle of February each year, Marlow Cemetery employees perform annual clean-up of the grounds.

The main focus of the clean-up is to remove all aging and faded flowers that are on the ground and all easels.

Family members and caretakers should remove all Christmas flowers, decorations and blankets if those items are to be kept. If not, those items will be removed by Cemetery Personnel.

Flowers on the monuments will be removed **ONLY IF** those items are shedding leaves and petals thus making a mess on the ground. **There shall be no articles such as flags, flowers, statues and so forth placed at the foot of the grave.** Flowers placed anywhere other than on the stone or at the side of the stone will be removed and disposed of during this clean-up.

Cut and artificial flowers are permitted if those items are placed in vases attached to the monument or on the top of the monument in a saddle. If there are no vases available on the stone, PVC pipe is allowed, but only on the ends of the monument or temporary marker.

There shall be no glass jars, bottles, vases, globes, tin cans or other containers used on the premises for holding any floral products. Rockers, metal rods, wire stakes or other items to secure decorations are prohibited, as they will lead to maintenance problems and hamper mowing and trimming.
