

## **Chapter 105 – Complete Prohibition of Recreational and Adult Use Marihuana Establishments**

- 105.1 Intent and Purpose- The Michigan Regulation and Taxation of Marihuana Act, Initiated Law 1 of 2018, MCL 333.27951 et. seq., and more specifically Section 6 (1) thereof, MCL 333.27956 (1), authorizes municipalities to completely prohibit recreational or adult use marihuana establishments within the City boundaries, even though otherwise allowed under the law. This can be accomplished through the adoption of an ordinance.
- 105.2 Definitions- Words used in this Ordinance shall have the definitions as provided for in the Michigan Regulation and Taxation of Marihuana Act, Initiated Law 1 of 2018, MCL 333.27951 et. seq., and the corresponding State of Michigan Administrative Rules, as may be amended.
- 105.3 Prohibition- As allowed under the Michigan Regulation and Taxation of Marihuana Act, Initiated Law 1 of 2018, MCL 333.27951 et. seq., all recreational or adult use marihuana establishments are completely prohibited within the boundaries of the City of Troy.
- 105.4 Penalty- A person who violates this ordinance is guilty of a misdemeanor, punishable by a fine of not more than \$500 and/or up to 90 days in jail.
