Troy Police Arrest Somerset Collection Shooting Suspects

Troy Police have arrested two men in connection with the “shots fired” incident that happened on Sunday night in the parking lot of the Somerset Collection at approximately 4:30 p.m.

Jermaine Marzell Jones, 25 years old, of Van Buren Township was charged with Possession of a Firearm by a Felon, Felony Firearm 2nd Offense, Carrying a Concealed Weapon and Reckless Use of a Firearm.

Daniel Rashard Bright, 24 years old, of Sterling Heights was charged with Possession of a Controlled Substance and Driving While License Suspended.

The two men were together in a gray Impala in the Neiman Marcus parking lot when Jones exchanged gunfire with four men in another car, a dark gray or silver boxy SUV, possibly a Dodge Durango. The other group of men is still at large.

What led up to the shooting is still unknown. Officers were called to the scene after witnesses heard shots fired in the parking lot. Four vehicles in the parking lot, including the Impala, were struck by gunfire.

Casings from at least two different guns were found on the scene. It is unknown if the gray or silver SUV or any of the occupants were hit by gunfire.
