LARCENY FROM AUTO ARREST

Officers of the Troy Special Investigations Unit and Shelby Township Special Investigations Unit were working an investigation involving three subjects from Florida believed to be in the area targeting larceny from vehicles in the parking lots of fitness and daycare centers.

Early this morning the three suspects were observed breaking into multiple vehicles in the parking lot of a daycare facility in the area of Livernois and M-59. Previously they had been in the parking lot of a fitness center in the area of Rochester Rd and Hamlin.

Once a theft was confirmed Officers blocked the vehicle in a parking space to prevent a vehicle pursuit and the two suspect males immediately fled on foot. Both were captured within the parking lot after a brief foot chase. The female suspect used this opportunity to escape on foot. Officers secured the male suspects and began to organize a perimeter to locate the female suspect.

A short time later Troy Special Investigations Officers learned that a female had been struck on M-59 near Livernois. Officer coordinated with the Oakland County Sherriff's Office who were responding to the crash in their jurisdiction.

Officers were able to confirm the victim of the crash, which now had been confirmed as a hit and run, was the female suspect of the Larceny from Auto incident.

Troy Special Investigation Officers provided information and completed arrest reports at the Oakland County Sherriff's Office substation.

The two male suspects will be held at Oakland County Jail until arraignment within the next several days. The Troy Police Department will send an updated release with any issued charges after the arraignment occurs.

The Oakland County Sherriff's Office is handling the traffic crash investigation and has issued a separate press release this afternoon.
