### **UPDATE: Officer Involved Shooting at E Big Beaver and Rochester**

At 3:15 pm on Tuesday November 21<sup>st</sup> Officers were alerted to a stolen vehicle from a Flock license plate reader in the City of Troy. The vehicle was originally stolen from a car dealership in Southfield on November 6<sup>th</sup>.

At 3:21 pm Officers attempted to box in the stolen vehicle on E Big Beaver, west of Daley, while it was stopped at a traffic signal. The driver of the stolen vehicle began to ram his way out of the attempted box and then drove straight at an Officer who had exited his vehicle to make an arrest. The Officer fired five rounds from his service weapon and struck the driver in the upper body one time. Of note, during the investigation all five rounds fired were accounted for within the suspect vehicle. The suspect vehicle continued a short distance before crashing into another vehicle. Officers were then able to take the driver and passenger of the stolen vehicle into custody and give medical aid.

The driver, a 25-year-old male from Detroit, was transported to a local hospital where he remains in custody and in stable condition.

The passenger, a 20-year-old male from Detroit, was treated for minor injuries resulting from the suspect's attempt to ram his way out of the vehicle stop. The passenger has been released from the hospital and is in custody on two active Felony warrants from other local jurisdictions.

Westbound E. Big Beaver was closed at Daley as the Oakland County Sheriff's Office completed their on-scene investigation. It was reopened to traffic shortly after 9:00 pm.

Investigators continue to work towards securing charges and arraignment and we will update when additional information is available.
