# CALLED COUNCIL MEETING 2019 MILLAGE RATE AND TAX DIGEST ADOPTION JULY 31, 2019

## CALLED COUNCIL MEETING

The Called Meeting of the Mayor and Council of the City of Cleveland was called to order by Mayor Pro Tem Bradley Greene at 9:00 a.m. Mayor Shan Ash was absent.

**COUNCIL MEMBERS PRESENT**: Nan Bowen, Annie Sutton, Kevin Stanley, and Bradley Greene.

## APPROVAL OF AGENDA

On motion by Kevin Stanley, seconded by Nan Bowen, in favor – Annie Sutton and carried unanimously, the Mayor Pro Tem and Council voted to approve the agenda for the Called Council Meeting of July 31, 2019.

## 2019 MILLAGE RATE AND DIGEST - ADOPTION

Mayor Tem Bradley Greene explained the purpose of the meeting is to reaffirm the vote and adoption of the 2019 Millage adopted July 25, 2019.

On motion by Kevin Stanley, seconded by Nan Bowen, in favor Annie Sutton, and carried unanimously by the Mayor Pro Tem and City Council, to reaffirm the vote and approval, through a unanimous decision of the Cleveland City Council on July 25, 2019, to set the 2019 millage rate at 6.00 from the rollback of 5.899 a difference of 0.101.

The following resolution was approved and adopted and authorization was given to Mayor Pro Tem Bradley Greene to sign the appropriate documents to submit to the White County Tax Commissioner's Office and the State of Georgia.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Georgia Code Section 48-8-80, et seq., a joint county and municipal sales and use tax was instituted in White County, Georgia, and the municipalities located therein; and

WHEREAS, also pursuant to Georgia Code Section 48-8-80 et seq., all revenue realized by White County and the participating municipalities located therein from said sales and use tax shall be applied against the local tax rate structures in such a way as to reduce the net amounts of the total ad valorem tax bills in White County; and WHEREAS, The Mayor and City Council of Cleveland held three public hearings for citizen input of the increase in the millage rate July 18, 2019 9:00 a.m.; July 18, 2019 6:00 p.m.; July 25, 2019 9:00 a.m.; and to reaffirm adoption of millage rate on July 31, 2019 9:00 a.m.; and

WHEREAS, the millage rate for the City of Cleveland for 2019 is 6.00; and

WHEREAS, the City of Cleveland, an incorporated municipality, shall receive a 10.00 mill roll-back for the local options sales tax; and

**WHEREAS**, as a result of the roll-back, the millage rate for the City of Cleveland shall be reduced by 10.00 mills, leaving a net millage rate of 6.00 for 2019.

## CITY OF CLEVELAND, GEORGIA AN ORDINANCE TO SET THE 2019 MILLAGE RATE FOR THE CITY OF CLEVELAND, GEORGIA, TO LEVY THE SAME, AND TO ROLLBACK SAID MILLAGE RESOLUTION 2019-07

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Georgia Code Section 48-8-80, et seq., a joint county and municipal sales and use tax was instituted in White County, Georgia, and the municipalities located therein; and

WHEREAS, also pursuant to Georgia Code Section 48-8-80 et seq., all revenue realized by White County and the participating municipalities located therein from said sales and use tax shall be applied against the local tax rate structures in such a way as to reduce the net amounts of the total ad valorem tax bills in White County; and

**WHEREAS**, The Mayor and City Council of Cleveland held three public hearings for citizen input of the increase in the millage rate July 18, 2019 9:00 a.m.; July 18, 2019 6:00 p.m.; July 25, 2019 9:00 a.m.; and to reaffirm adoption of millage rate on July 31, 2019 9:00 a.m.; and

WHEREAS, the millage rate for the City of Cleveland for 2019 is 6.00; and

WHEREAS, the City of Cleveland, an incorporated municipality, shall receive a 10.00 mill roll-back for the local options sales tax; and

**WHEREAS**, as a result of the roll-back, the millage rate for the City of Cleveland shall be reduced by 10.00 mills, leaving a net millage rate of 6.00 for 2019.

NOW THEREFORE, UPON MOTION BEING DULY MADE AND SECONDED, AND CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY, THE FOLLOWING RESOLUTION IS ADOPTED:

**BE IT RESOLVED** that the City of Cleveland Mayor and City Council hereby sets a net millage rate of 6.00 mills for the 2019 tax year on all taxable property in the incorporated areas of the City of Cleveland.
