The City, and the City's Economic Development Commission, welcome Goodwill to the community. Their new store is located at 1006 NE C Street (NW corner of C & Myra Rd). The ribbon cutting will be held on August 17<sup>th</sup>, 2022 at 11:00 AM.

The City continues to be busy with a plethora of infrastructure projects. The Southwest Sewer Trunk Line Project is finally complete with College Avenue, south of Lamperti, stabilized and resurfaced. Nelson Corp is finishing up the Well-House for replacement of drinking water well #2 at the southwest corner of Whitman & Maple. That well should be active by the end of October. The City and the Park Board continue to work on final engineering plans for the Lions Park renovation. The construction on that project will take place throughout 2023.

The City will be undertaking the Fiscal Year 2023 budget process. This process starts with a publicly available survey to garner citizen's opinions on city services, projects, and priorities.
