(Ask about our Gold Brush Membership)

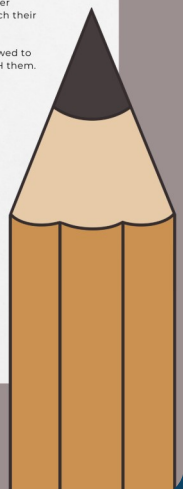
AFTER SCHOOL ART CLASSES
