Working Washington Grants: Round 5

Washington State Legislature has allocated a new round of grant funding for small businesses affected by the pandemic. \$70 million was appropriated by the legislature for the next round of Working Washington Grants: Round 5. In this round of Working Washington grants, available funds are set aside for specific targeted groups or sectors:

- 60% is identified for the arts, heritage, and science sectors, including those that operate live entertainment venues
- 40% is identified for most other sectors, including hospitality, fitness and personal services

General Timeline:

- August 17 September 9: Application portal will remain open for 24 days
- Mid Late September: Review of applications
