##### EMAIL

In order to sign up online, you must have a personal email. Come prepared with your email and password to verify your new utility account.



##### UTILITY BILL

Bring a copy of your most recent utility bill. **Account numbers have changed from the old system.** You will need your **new account number** and your last payment amount.



##### COMPUTER

The College Place Library has three computers that are **FREE** to use! They're secure and there are instructions to set up your account at the Library!

What if I don't have my account number or last payment amount?



Your account number is located on the top right hand corner of your new utility bill. If you don't have your current bill, call City Hall to get that information.
