WHEREAS, the AARP has a Community Challenge program which awards grants to cities and non-profits for small capital projects; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of College Place (City) wishes to submit and support a Community Challenge Grant application for to install free wireless internet at Kiwanis Park, Lions Park, Veterans Park, and the College Place Municipal Campus.

Now therefore, be it Resolved that the City Council of the City of College Place does hereby

Section 1: The City Council of College Place, Washington authorizes and fully supports the AARP Community Challenge Grant to install free wireless internet hotspot locations at Kiwanis Park, Lions Park, Veterans Park, and the College Place Municipal Campus.
