A RESOLUTION BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLLEGE PLACE, WASHINGTON REGARDING DECLARING OFFICIAL COMMUNITY EVENTS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2021 FOR THE CITY OF COLLEGE PLACE, WASHINGTON

Whereas, the City of College Place is a non-charter code city governed by the rules and regulations of RCW 35A; and

Whereas, the City recognizes and acknowledges the importance of public special events that serve to enrich the civic, charitable, cultural, economic, entertainment, and other values of the community that enhance community identity; and

Whereas, the City further recognizes that the limited economic, staff, and other resources of the City require that the City provide City support only to those special events that uniquely promote and advance public objectives; and

Whereas, the City deems it appropriate to identify on an annual basis those Community Events which may receive City sponsorship and support; and

Whereas, the declaration of a public event as a Community Event may, at the sole discretion of the City, include provision of City resources.

Now therefore, be it resolved that the City Council of the City of College Place does hereby

Section 1. Sanction the following events as Official Community Events of the City of College Place, Washington.

- Earth Day
- Garrison Creek Clean-Up
- Fishing Derby at Lions Park
- Neighborhood Engagement/Outreach events as outlined in forthcoming Neighborhood Engagement and Outreach Plan
- Block Party
- College Place Farmers & Artisan Market
- Movies at the Park
- Freedom Festival
- College Place Arbor Day
- Fall Festival
- Walla Walla Valley Veterans Day Parade
- Winterfest

- Light up the Avenue
