The Executive budget is fairly status quo with some minor changes due to the infusion of American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) dollars. The training line item will remain steady from previous years as most of the trainings (if COVID-19 blows over and are held) are located within the Pacific Northwest with the exception of the retail recruitment event (International Council of Shopping Centers Convention) in Las Vegas. For the ICSC event the Port pays for airfare and admission to the event. The City pays for the hotel and food.

The Legislative budget proposal is status quo. The lobbyist is expected to charge the same that was charged last year (#511-70-49-00).

Fiscal Year 2022 will be the fifth cohort of the Walla Walla Valley Microbusiness Assistance Program which we contribute to in partnership with the City of Walla Walla, Port of Walla Walla, and various financial institutions. This year the City will contribute \$68,000 comprised of the remaining \$60,000 in Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds and the City was awarded in late 2020 as well as \$8,000 in local funds to pay for 7 seats into the program for FY 2021.

The City contributed \$10,000 for the youth recreation program in 2021 with budgeted 2020 dollars since it did not happen that year due to COVID-19 restrictions. The City has allocated \$30,000 of ARPA grant dollars to start to build a shared youth recreation program between College Place Public Schools, United Way, Campfire, and Sonbridge.
