## Records Department Hours

The College Place Police Department Records Division walk-in hours have been changed. The walk-in window at city hall will now be open from 8:00am to 5:00pm, Monday-Friday, excluding holidays. You will still be able to contact the police department by calling (509) 525-7778 between 8:00am and 10:00pm, Monday-Friday; before or after those hours, your call will automatically be transferred to the dispatch non-emergency number.

Some of the services the Records Division can assist you with are:

- Obtaining a copy of your collision report
- Applicant fingerprinting for any number of employment positions - \$5 per card
- Providing a Clearance Letter as requested for a VISA application - \$10 fee
- Applying for a Concealed Pistol License - \$55.25 for initial CPL
- Licensing your dog in the City of College Place - \$5 for altered dog/\$10 for intact
- Signing up for Vacation House Checks – no fee
- Bike licensing - \$1 annually or \$5 lifetime
- Solicitor License issuance - \$50 fee
- Verification of police report - \$3 fee
- Requests for Public Records - \$.20 a page
- Requests for Audio/Video records - \$10 per incident
- Special Event application - \$50 fee
- Getting your dog out of impound - \$10 impound fee (plus licensing fee if applicable)

## Myra Road Project

Construction crews will soon begin work on the long awaited Myra Road project. The City of Walla Walla is providing project information at [www.gowallawalla.us](http://www.gowallawalla.us). Preliminary project details listed on the website are as follows:

**Myra Road: State Route 125 to Garrison Creek Project:** This project is the last step in a long-term plan to redirect truck traffic from Ninth Avenue to Myra Road. This summer, we will lower the steep intersection of Myra Road and The Dalles Military Road by approximately eight feet to improve sight distance and meet access requirements for trucks traveling between Highway 12 and State Route 125.

**Construction is anticipated to begin in July and continue through November.** During this time, the intersection of Myra Road and The Dalles Military Road will be

closed to all traffic. Detours will be in place; however, all businesses in the area will remain accessible during construction. Access for businesses on The Dalles Military Road will be from the east, by way of Ninth Avenue. Access for the Twelfth Street businesses in College Place will be from the west on Twelfth Street. Access to Stone Creek Place businesses — Petco and Big-5 — will be from the south by way of State Route 125. Community Bank will be accessible from the west by using SE Commercial Drive.

Funding is provided from several sources, including multiple federal and state grants matched with local funding from the cities of Walla Walla and College Place.
