A RESOLUTION REGARDING THE SUSPENSION OF THE VOLUNTARY CURBSIDE RECYCLING PROGRAM WITHIN THE CITY OF COLLEGE PLACE:

Whereas, the City of College Place has allowed voluntary curbside recycling for its residents;
and

Whereas, the commodity markets for recyclable materials have become unaffordable and unsustainable; and

Whereas, the quality of the recyclable material collected has become so strict the cost of compliance has become unaffordable; and

Whereas, the majority of the recyclable material is being landfilled and not wanting the public to be deceived;

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of College Place, Washington, as follows:

The voluntary recycling program in the City of College Place is suspended as of _____, 2018 until such time as the market prices make the cost of recycling affordable.
