



RSQ – WI-FI HOTSPOT INSTALLATIONS

DUE DATE: FRIDAY, AUGUST 13TH 2021 AT 4:00 PM (Pacific Time)

The City recently obtained a AARP Community Challenge Grant (<https://states.aarp.org/washington/aarp-awards-community-grants-to-three-washington-organizations-as-part-of-another-record-breaking-year-for-nationwide-program>) for \$18,350 to install infrastructure for free wi-fi at Lions Park (801 SE Larch Avenue), Kiwanis Park (NE corner of 3rd & Date), Veterans Park (450 SW Doans Avenue), and the College Place Municipal Campus (625 S. College Avenue). Infrastructure installed must be strong enough to provide a wifi signal for residents in areas highlighted in the maps down below. Submittals need to include:

- Project Team
- Related Project Experience
- Explanation of Method of Implementation
- Certification of Ability to meet deliverables for wifi install at the above mentioned four sites.
- Estimated cost of installation
- Estimated monthly cost of service

Submittals will be graded by 20% project team, 20% project experience, 40% method of implementation, 20% ability to meet deliverables.
