SPECIAL COMMISSION MEETING MINUTES

A Special Meeting of the Board of Commissioners was held at the Collingswood Senior Community Center at 4:00 A.M. The meeting was called to order by Mayor M. James Maley, Jr. with Commissioner Robert Lewandowski absent and Commissioner Morgan Robinson present.

After the flag salute, Mayor Maley read the 48- hour sunshine law stating that the Borough complied with the 48-hour notice provisions of the Sunshine Law by giving written advance notice of at least two local newspapers, stating the time, date, location and to the extent known, the agenda of this meeting and copies of the notice were posted in the Borough Hall and filed with the Borough Clerk.
