COMMISSION MEETING MINUTES

A regular meeting of the Board of Commissioners was held at the Collingswood Borough Hall, 678 Haddon Ave. Collingswood, NJ, on the third floor, at 10:00 A.M. Mayor M. James Maley, Jr. *called the meeting to order*, with Commissioner Joan Leonard *present* and Commissioner Robert Lewandowski *present*.

Mayor Maley read the Sunshine Notice stating that the Borough has complied with provisions of the Sunshine Law by adopting by January 10 of this year, a resolution prescribing the dates, times and locations of all regular meetings of the Commission. Mayor Maley led the Pledge of Allegiance.

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 293 OF THE BOROUGH OF COLLINGSWOOD CODE
REGARDING
VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC.**

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Borough Commission of the BOROUGH OF COLLINGSWOOD, that the following Chapter of the Borough Code be amended as follows:

I. ENACTMENTS

A.) **Chapter 293, Section 24, subsection A**, “Exceptions to parking restrictions for certain residents; insignia required,” shall be amended to add the following areas for which parking permits or insignia are required:

(i) Maple Avenue between Washington Avenue and the driveway of Washington Arms.

B.) **Chapter 293, Section 61 Schedule XII** “Parking Prohibited at all Times” shall be amended to add the following streets: Maple Avenue between Washington Avenue and the driveway of Washington Arms.

II. EFFECTIVE DATE

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final passage, approval, and publication, as provided by law.

ORDINANCE NO. 1653

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 141 OF THE BOROUGH OF COLLINGSWOOD
DEVELOPMENT REGULATIONS**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of the Borough of Collingswood that the Development Regulations are hereby amended as follow:

I. PURPOSE.

The purpose of this Ordinance is to amend Chapter 141; Development Regulations of the Borough Code. The Borough has determined that amending the Chapter is in the best interest of the Borough's residents.

II. **AMENDMENTS.**

1. Section 141- 93.C (11)

Shall be changed to:

Floodlights, spotlights, and directed lights as part of a business ornamentation or sign illumination system that are not hooded or shielded so that the light source is not visible from any public right-of-way or adjacent property.

2. Section 141- 93.C (12)

Shall be changed to:

Unless otherwise exempted by 141-93(B)(1)(b), exposed neon and other exposed charged gas tube lighting fixtures, as well as other types of lighting fixtures used to simulate them, which are used for business identification signage, accessory signage, or ornamentation, may be used by businesses in the historic district with a certificate of appropriateness by the Historic Preservation Commission.

III. **EFFECTIVE DATE.**

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final passage, approval, and publication, as provided by law .

SALARY ORDINANCE

AN ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE FOR AND DETERMINE THE RATE OF COMPENSATION OF EACH OFFICER AND EMPLOYEE OF THE BOROUGH OF COLLINGSWOOD AND METHOD OF PAYMENT OF SUCH COMPENSATION

THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE BOROUGH OF COLLINGSWOOD IN THE COUNTY OF CAMDEN, AND STATE OF NEW JERSEY DOES ORDAIN:

SECTION 1. THE RATE OF COMPENSATION OF EACH OFFICER AND EMPLOYEE OF THE BOROUGH OF COLLINGSWOOD, WHOSE COMPENSATION SHALL BE ON AN ANNUAL, SEMI-ANNUAL, AND BIWEEKLY BASIS, SHALL BE PAYABLE AS FOLLOWS:

POSITION

ANNUAL SALARY

SENIOR COMMUNITY CENTER

Director

\$15,000.00 to \$45,000.00

SECTION 2. ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES INCONSISTENT WITH THIS ORDINANCE ARE HEREBY REPEALED. FULL TIME EMPLOYEES OF THE BOROUGH SHALL IN ADDITION TO THE COMPENSATION PROVIDED

FOR HEREIN, SHALL RECEIVE LONGEVITY PAY, WHICH SHALL BE PAYABLE ONCE YEARLY OR AS SET FORTH IN LABOR CONTRACT, RATIFIED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS.

SECTION 3. ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES INCONSISTENT WITH THIS ORDINANCE ARE HEREBY REPEALED.

SECTION 4. THIS ORDINANCE SHALL TAKE EFFECT UPON ITS PASSAGE AND PUBLICATION ACCORDING TO LAW.
