SPECIAL COMMISSION MEETING MINUTES
BOROUGH OF COLLINGSWOOD, NJ

A Special Meeting of the Board of Commissioners was held at the Collingswood Borough Hall, 678 Haddon Avenue, third floor, at 10:00 A.M. The meeting was called to order by Mayor M. James Maley, Jr. with Commissioner Joan Leonard and Commissioner Robert Lewandowski present.

After the flag salute, Mayor Maley read the 48 hour sunshine law stating that the Borough complied with the 48 hour notice provisions of the Sunshine Law by giving written advance notice of at least two local newspapers, stating the time, date, location and to the extent known, the agenda of this meeting and copies of the notice were posted in the Borough Hall and filed with the Borough Clerk.

Mayor Maley explained that there are also some additional bonds that will be coming off the books that will eliminate the need for additional borrowing and there is additional revenue from a couple of PILOTs that will allow us devote some funds to infrastructure. Mayor Maley explained because of the net effect of these things, he believes there should be no impact on taxes.
