FRESH, NUTRITIOUS FOOD IS A RIGHT, NOT A PRIVILEGE

New for the 2023 Season, the Collingswood Farmers' Market is proud to be authorized by the USDA to accept **Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program benefits (SNAP)**.

Customers who wish to use their SNAP/EBT card can stop by the Market Info Tent to purchase wooden Market tokens to shop for authorized foods (see list below). Standard SNAP/EBT restrictions apply and farms/vendors may not give any change on the tokens. SNAP tokens do not have an expiration date and may be used at any time during the Market season.

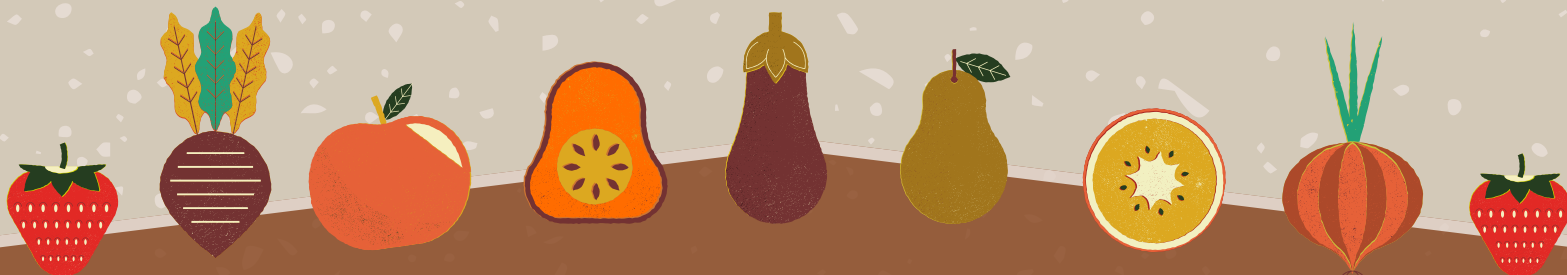
Customers can use SNAP benefits to buy foods for the household to eat such as:

- **Breads, Cereals, Cookies, Crackers, Bakery Items**
- **Fresh Fruits & Vegetables**
- **Meats, Fish & Poultry**
- **Ice Cream**
- **Seeds or plants which produce food**

The tokens may not be used to purchase: hot food or any food sold for on-premises consumption, alcohol or non-food items such as flowers, cosmetics, grooming items or soaps.
