**APPLICATION FOR VEGETATION CONTROL (“NO SPRAY”) PERMIT**  
**PERMIT FEE: \$50.00**

The approval and issuance of a Permit for vegetation control on a County road allows the Applicant to manage vegetation and control noxious weeds on designated County right-of-way property. Please contact the Road Department Office if you have any questions about this Application or the Permit.

**The \$50.00 Permit Fee must be included with your Application or it will not be processed.**

**Please contact the Road Department Office if you have any questions about this Application or the Vegetation Control Permit. This permit allows the property owner to control vegetation on the indicated County right-of-way for a period of two years. Incomplete applications will not be accepted.**

## **SECTION 2 - AGREEMENT**

**By submitting this Application, the Applicant agrees as follows:**

1. 'NO SPRAY' signs will be placed along the County right-of-way bordering the subject property. The Applicant is responsible for removing any and all vegetation from the posted area that is obstructing vehicle driver visibility, interfering with water drainage, or damaging the roadbed as provided by ORS 368.251 and ORS 368.256. The Maintenance of the signs is Applicant's responsibility. Damaged or vandalized signs will be replaced by the Road Department Office upon request.
2. No work shall be performed within the paved surface of County roads, or that would in any way restrict the proper functioning of road drainage infrastructure. Extreme caution should be exercised while working near the County road. All work performed shall not in any way interfere with traffic.
3. The applicant undertakes the responsibilities under this Permit Application at their own risk and shall indemnify Curry County and its agents and employees and hold them harmless from any and all liability for damages, costs, losses, and expenses proximately resulting from the applicant's failure to perform fully hereunder. Further, the applicant agrees to defend Curry County and its agents and employees against all suits, actions, or proceedings brought to recover damages or other compensation for the actual negligence of the applicant in abating weeds, brush, and other vegetation in accordance with this Permit Application.
4. Should this Permit be revoked, the Road Department is authorized to charge the property owner actual costs for crew labor and materials used to abate vegetation.

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## **SECTION 3 - INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS**

1. Place signs on road right-of-way/property line facing the centerline of the road. One sign should be placed at the beginning of the property or area not to be treated. Another sign should be placed at the end of the property or area not to be treated.
2. Signs should be fixed to a fence post, a sturdy pole, or some other steady object, at least four (4) feet above ground level. If the sign is not visible, it may be moved closer to the road shoulder so that it will be four (4) feet above the shoulder. No sign shall be placed on the shoulder of the road or any closer than three (3) feet to the edge of pavement.
3. Keep all weeds, grass, brush, and limbs cut away from the signs so they are easily seen by vegetation crews.
4. If both you and your neighbor are placing signs, please make sure that the signs are placed side by side, next to each other, to avoid mistakes being made by the vegetation crew.
