A sign-up sheet for public comment will be available 30 minutes prior to each applicable meeting and will be closed and removed at the start of the meeting. If you wish to address the City Council, you must indicate which agenda item you wish to provide comment. Only those members of the public that have signed the sign-up sheet prior to the start of the meeting will be permitted to address the City Council. PUBLIC COMMENTS ARE LIMITED TO AGENDA ITEMS ONLY. Members of the public wishing to address an item NOT on the agenda must first contact the City Manager or other appropriate city official who will determine whether or not such item should be placed on the agenda.**


Public comments shall be taken in the order in which the sign-up is listed. Members of the public wishing to address the City Council shall be limited to 3 minutes. However,

if there are more people wishing to address the City Council than can be heard in the 30 minute public comment period and in order to hear opposing views, the City Council by motion can limit each speaker to 2 minutes and/or require the public to limit the number of speakers addressing the City Council on the same subject and expressing the same viewpoint. All members of the public signing up for comment shall be required to review the rules of procedure for public comment.

The City Council reserves the right to temporarily suspend these rules of procedure upon a motion, second and majority vote of the City Council.
